She is past Chair of IAGP Psychodrama Section 2003-2009, Past Vice-President of Portuguese Psychodrama Association, teacher and supervisor of Sociodrama and Psychodrama at SPP, Founder of International Sociodrama Conference and of International Transgenerational Conference.. Manuela is certified in psychogeneology by Anne Schutzenberger. She writes extensively and leads workshops and trainings all over the world and is co-editor of Advances in Theory and Practice in Psychodrama.</p>

He is a former chairman of the Section for Group Analysis in IAGP and current Vice-President of the International Organisation for Group Analytic Psychotherapy (IOGAP). Felix is a well known author through books and articles on the group in psychotherapy. He is a professor at the Sigmund-Freud University of Vienna and also teaches at the Deutsche Akademie für Psychoanalyse (DAP) in Berlin. His new book 'The Man Who Owed his Life to a Dream' (in German) will be published in October 2014.</p>
<p>Sociodrama in the 21st Century</p>	<p>Dr Marineau is a Professor of Psychology at the Université du Québec in Montréal, Canada. He is a trainer in group psychotherapy and psychodrama. He practises expressive therapy integrating theories of Moreno, Freud, Reich and Rogers. He is the author of the biography 'Jacob Levi Moreno 1889-1974: Father of psychodrama, sociometry, and group psychotherapy'.</p>
